Cay offered to donate equipment, electric, time, etc; club would just need to purchase film

Community Service Hours: Have reached out to youth organizations with no previous luck. Need to have dates and locations scheduled in advance.

Sept 14-15<sup>th</sup> at Bainbridge not necessarily ideal for Kid Trail Building but could utilize some youth volunteers to help with basic maintenance, such as raking and/or marking.

Contact Outdoors Clubs and Environmental Groups at local high schools and colleges to see if they have students who want outreach experience (resume builders, job skills, etc.) We could set-up trail maintenance schedules and provide equipment for them; would not include trail building which would need more hands-on direction supervision. Also, plan activities to attract students at SU.
